GCSE Results Day

GCSE results will be available on **Thursday 22 August 2019 between 9.00am and 12.00 noon** for you to come in and collect.

If you are unable to make this day, you can provide someone with a note, signed by you, giving them permission to collect them on your behalf. You can also leave a stamped addressed envelope with the Exams Officer who will post them out results day for you. This must be left with the Exams Officer before you leave in the Summer.

Enquiries About Results

If you did not get the grade you were expecting then it may be possible to request a re-mark of your exam paper, depending on how close you are to the next grade boundary. This must be discussed carefully with your subject teacher as grades can go down as well as up. Members of staff will be around on results day for you to discuss any concerns with.

A consent form will be sent out to you for you to read carefully and sign to agree to us making the enquiry.

If college request the appeal then the fees will be paid for by college.

If you request the appeal then any fees must be paid by you. Please ask the Exams Officer for the current fees.

Enquiries can take a few weeks to be returned. You will be informed by letter of the outcome.

Certificates

Certificates will be given out on Awards Presentation Evening held in November. You will be sent details of this by college in September/October.

If you are unable to make this evening, certificates will be available after the evening has taken place.

Please keep your certificates safe, they cost around £45 each to replace.

If you need to replace certificates, you will need to apply to the exam board directly.
