Dear Families,

I just wanted to reassure you all around some positive cases of covid we have had in recent weeks and why no students have had to isolate.

In recent weeks we have had several cases of coronavirus with students' parents or carers. A student will then begin the 14 days isolation period at home with their ill family member. Unfortunately, in a number of cases the child then goes on to develop covid symptoms several days after being in school; but this has always been more than 48 hours after they were last in school. In many cases it is actually 5 or 6 days later when they are showing symptoms.

I know this is a very worrying time for us all and it is important you all feel as reassured as possible. We are discouraging all children and families from posting covid details on social media etc., which then worry other families in school.

Please rest assured we continue to take all possible steps to keep everyone as safe as we can. We are always here if you need to ask us a question or are worried about anything. Remember if your child is isolating but not ill they can access almost all their lessons online now, live from the classroom! Do get in touch if you are having any issues with this.

Finally, can I thank you all for your excellent communication with us around coronavirus issues in your families and thank you for always erring on the side of caution in terms of keeping children at home at the first signs of any symptoms in your homes. It is greatly appreciated.
