Please also remember to report any covid positives to our covid-19 email over Easter. Depending on when these are reported we may be contacting families at the start of Easter and requesting a child isolates. Apologies if we have to do this but it is still the reality of the current situation.

If you do report any cases to the covid19 email it might be the following day you are contacted as we will be checking the emails only up to 12 noon each day.

Please watch out for any update messages over the holiday about masks or any other changes.

Please do not send any child back to school on 12<sup>th</sup> April if you suspect they or anyone else in the household has coronavirus.

As ever, I remain incredibly proud of our Shuttleworth community and thank you all for your unwavering support.
