Dear Families

I just wanted to update you on some action we have taken today at the school site in relation to the coronavirus.

One of the teachers who was on our site last week with Burnley High School has tested positive for the virus this week. I was informed first thing this morning.

As a result of this news we have contacted all families who have had children on site this week and last and advised them to isolate their children for 14 days as a precaution. We will be offering resumed provision for these children from Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May.

Any of our staff who were in school last week or this week are getting tested today or tomorrow.

The school building is being deep cleaned tomorrow and will be safe to use after that time, so no-one will be on site tomorrow. Once the building has been cleaned and we have our test results we will open the site up again. I will let you know as soon as we do this.

We are being ultra-cautious as we want to minimise the risk to everyone in our community. I am really sorry for any issues this causes key worker families and others.

Please note we are still open in terms of all other support; phone, email, welfare contact - nothing has changed. We will also be able to send out more equipment and work packs as soon as we reopen the site next week.
