

Dear Parent/Carer

Each year our year 11 students participate in a 'period 6' programme which provides support, guidance and intervention towards their end of year exams.

With the changes to the timings of the school day, some of this time has been integrated into the timetable but with differing students' needs, experiences during lockdown and periods of isolation over the past term, we believe it is important to continue this additional offering for selected students.

In class assessment and reporting have been used to identify specific students who would benefit from additional support and intervention to help them to reach their potential in each subject. The timetable, for the most part, focuses on remote delivery, with students logging in after school for sessions through teams.

These run throughout the evening, with a protected break each evening, and with some interventions on a Saturday morning, in line with previous years. Each subject intervention is planned to run for a short period of time, between 1 and 6 weeks, providing a short term, intensive programme to small groups of students.

Students will be selected by curriculum leaders the week prior to each intervention, and added to the revision team, or spoken to by their subject teacher. We will also send a text reminder to you prior to the intervention. We appreciate your support in encouraging your child's engagement with this programme.
