If you have any issues with this, then please email ICTsupport@shuttleworth.lancs.sch.uk with your full name and date of birth to explain what the issue is and we will help you resolve it in good time.

Whilst staff will **not** be in school on Results' Day, SLT, Mrs Ackroyd (Careers' Lead) and Curriculum Leaders will be available on the help@shuttleworth.lancs.sch.uk email address to answer any queries you have about your next steps. If you have any queries specifically about the grades you receive you can contact me directly via email at klightfoot@shuttleworth.lancs.sch.uk.

As you may be aware, there have been many last-minute changes to exam results in Scotland, and also with A-level results in England. We have not received any specific information about any further changes to GCSE results yet but will contact you when we know more. I will write to you next Thursday with as up-to-date details about grades and appeals as possible, and if relevant will include any further information such as mock grades in-line with the Government's guidance at the point results are released.

The week after Results' Day, beginning Monday 24th August, SLT and Mrs Ackroyd will be in school to meet with any of you that would like to discuss your next steps or any issues regarding your results in more detail.
